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**HOW MANY WAYS CAN YOU GET INFORMATION & ADVICE BEFORE LEARNING?**

**HOW LONG BEFORE YOU KNOW YOU ARE ON THE RIGHT COURSE FOR YOU?**

**PHONE, ENROL & START**  
1 MONTH  
This is the best approach if you know exactly what you want to learn. Otherwise, it is a good idea to contact us to check you will be on a course at the right level for you to avoid you wasting time.

**TASTER SESSION**  
3 HOURS  
A taster session is a great opportunity to meet the tutor and the group to get a feel of whether the course, venue and type of learning suits you.

**PATHFINDER AND MY PATHFINDER**  
UP TO 10 WEEKS  
Anyone can do the online Pathfinder course. We also have My Pathfinder which is a small group class for adults with supported learning needs. This aims to help you identify your goals and aspirations in life. You then work with a tutor to plan your future learning and support.

**INITIAL ASSESSMENT**  
1 LESSON  
Initial assessment is a way to find out what you know already. This takes place at the start of the course and helps your tutor to identify what you need to learn and ensure the course is the right level for you.

**IAG SESSION**  
1 HOUR  
Information, Advice and Guidance: This is a 1:1 conversation with a qualified careers adviser and usually takes 1 hour. Please talk to your nearest Adult Learning and Skills Centre to arrange this.
